(Mike/SELT) We need to do a 250 hr. service on the groomer. Jim Matthew reported on available signs. We have 48 intersections. There are 39 sponsor signs finished and installed. There are 14 remaining for sale. Cost is \$300 for businesses and \$250 for families.
