Jay reported gates by the cell tower and cleared trails back to Baxter Lake so that it will be easier for the groomer to pass. The state has been working on the rail trail from Spaulding HS to Power Junction. Signage for the trail. \$80,000 in gravel to resurface the trail. Chris Bolia reported the Den is in good shape. On Nov. 23 the drags will be set up at Trailside. Jim Matthew reported will still have intersection signs for sale.
